The exciting new C-Class Saloon and Estate have been completely redesigned inside and out to become, the most advanced and dynamic version ever of the best-selling Mercedes model. The product of the most demanding testing programme ever, the new C-Class combines pioneering design and cutting edge technology to produce a car that will deliver unprecedented levels of safety, comfort and driving dynamics in its sector.

Taller, longer and wider than the outgoing model, the new C-Class boasts a distinctive style with taut lines and large, tranquil surfaces. The wedge-shaped front end and wide, well-defined wheel arches emphasise the car's poise and performance, while the radiator grille design is used to help define between the SE and the Sport.

The redesign is complemented by high-tech drive train and safety features that include the pioneering Agility Control Package with selective damping system and the Pre-Safe® anticipatory safety system – both of which come as standard.

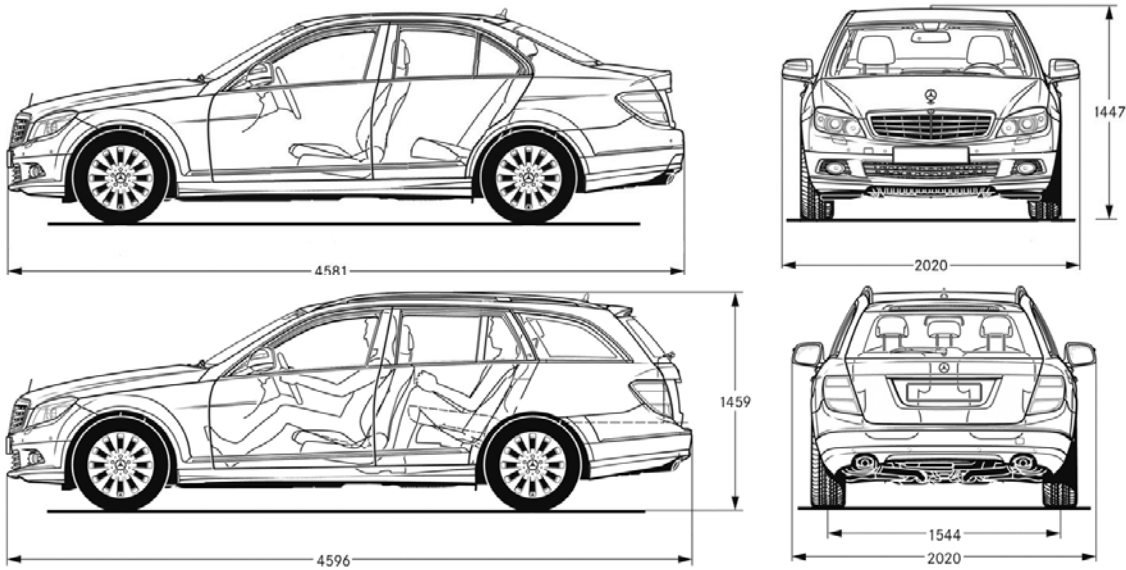
- Agility Control Package: with selective damping system reacts to the way the car is driven and the road it encounters thanks to the selective damping system that softens or firms damper settings according to the driving conditions. It can reduce body roll by up to 10 per cent.
- The new C-Class comes with seven airbags: a driver's kneebag, dual-stage airbags for driver and front passenger, front side bags and windowbags that cover practically the entire window area on each side. For added protection in a rear-end collision, Neck-Pro active head restraints move upwards and forwards within milliseconds to support the head sooner and lessen the likelihood of whiplash injuries.
- The award-winning Pre-Safe® anticipatory protection package, linked to the Electronic Stability Programme (ESP®) and Brake Assist (BAS), offers maximum protection to occupants in the event of an unavoidable accident. If a potentially critical situation is detected, Pre-Safe® can protect the occupants by activating the seat belt tensioners fitted to the front and outer rear seats and closing any side windows if open.
- The new C-Class comes with adaptive brake lights as standard. If the driver applies the brakes suddenly and forcefully, they automatically start flashing, providing a clearer warning to those behind.
- The extremely hard-wearing nano-particle paint is scratch-resistant and maintains the car's gloss up to 40% longer than conventional paint finishes. This 'non-particle clearcoat' paint binds microscopic ceramic particles together to form an extensively cross-linked network. This protects the outer skin like a shell.
- Supremely practical, the C-Class Estate is able to accommodate four golf bags including trolleys, nine large packing cases or a total of 44 drinks crates each containing six 1-litre juice bottles. The C-Class Estate also has the highest payload capacity in this class of estate car: a maximum of 605 kilograms.
- The new C-Class Sport not only looks more dynamic, it feels it too, thanks to sports suspension that's 15 millimetres lower than standard, speed-sensitive parameter steering with a more direct steering ratio, and drilled brake discs with front brake callipers featuring 'Mercedes-Benz' lettering.
